The 13th Annual Richland Pig Fest will bring more success and new projects to Broad Street in 2011.

This has been a very big year in Historic Downtown Richland. Because of you and your support of the Pig Fest, Richland Better Hometown has been able to commit \$10,000 to projects that will assist downtown merchants and the City of Richland. Progress this year includes:

- \$6,000 pledged to the "Stop & Shop" sign project which will promote Richland businesses on Hwy. 520. In September, two highway billboards will be constructed to promote our businesses and bring new customers off the highway and to downtown. Look for them soon!
- \$4,000 pledged to develop a park adjacent to the historic hotel. The park will provide shade and beauty all year. The park construction will begin in the first quarter of 2011 with the assistance of several in-kind partners. This is the first phase of work that will ring the hotel, creating a park-like setting. A band stand and Gazebo are planned for future phases. Please help us expedite this work by supporting Pig Fest this year as a sponsor.
- A \$150,000 HUD appropriation has been set aside for the City of Richland by Rep. Sanford Bishop. These funds are allocated for fiscal 2010 and will be available as early as November this year. This appropriation will fund many improvements downtown on Broad St. during the next 12 months.
- Richland Better Hometown worked in close association with Smith Furniture and Appliance to initiate the largest and most significant development in downtown Richland in more than 20 years. We salute and congratulate David Smith and his family and encourage everyone to shop locally and visit his store when they think furniture and home decorations.
